

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




All breast screening results are sent weekly by post when clients have had their NHS breast screening session closed by the breast screening service. This is sent physically to the practice for the attention of the practice manager.

1. Please nominate a member of admin staff to check the post regularly for breast screening results. Please see an example of results below:









Coding Results

- 2. Practice staff to save a copy of the clients' results on to the patients record by scanning it in.
 - Staff will then need to **code it with the relevant outcome** onto your practice system. This is **important** as results will reflect onto your screening data/dashboard.
- 3. In **resource publisher** use the 'Women's Health CEG'* template which has a mammography page to code the outcome of mammography results. Users can select from the three options or check declined accordingly as shown below:
 - *(please note that they appear slightly differently in each area and may vary in version type)



^{*}Ensure trans women and men and non-binary people's genders are recorded correctly on the GP system. Only people registered with a GP as a female are routinely invited for breast screening. People registered with a GP as male with no chest reconstruction can arrange mammograms at their local hospital. MTF patients on HRT can be screened. MTF pts not on HRT are not eligible to screen*





*** For practices who have an existing functional system in place to record coded entries for breast cancer screening outcomes into their patients' EHR, we recommend checking that the SNOMED codes used are contained within the Primary Care Domain refsets for Breast Cancer Screening codes.

Targeting non responders


4. You will be able to identify non-responders using the below Breast Cancer Screening searches 'Did not attend for breast cancer screening (3y) and declined breast cancer screening (3y). There are a set of patients who do not appear in any of the categories therefore there is a search 'neither screened/DNA'd/Declined' to identify this cohort and can also be targeted.

These patients will only be picked up if they are coded correctly as above.

5. **Send GP endorsed text messages**, messages on the patient's NHS app, email or letters to non-responders who have not attended their scheduled appointment/s. Please see an example text below:

Breast screening text messages to non-responders (following appointment outcome results) text message template:

Dear < forename >, We've been informed that you missed your breast screening appointment. We encourage you to attend screening, as the earlier we find cancer the more chance of cure. - 6. Practices to work with the breast screening service health promotion teams to support practices with targeted initiatives.
 - North, Central and East London Breast Screening Service (CELBSS)

The Health promotion team are offering to run DNA reports for the practice on a one-off request to identify their non-responder cohort. These reports would help for any health promotion activity; GP's are encouraged to contact DNA patients and remind them to rebook their appointment by calling the Hub/web booking. The Breast screening service can follow up and check the patients that were contacted in 6 months' time.

Outer North East London

The hub is offering to provide ad-hoc one off electronic reports to GPs who reach out directly, with the offer being specifically tied to efforts to promote screening uptake. These reports would help GPs update their patient records, particularly in preparation for any promotional activities related to breast screening awareness month.
